Custom Commission Contract

This contract ("Contract") is made and entered into on the date of acceptance by the client ("Client") and sets forth the terms and conditions of the custom commission ("Commission") to be provided by the artist ("Artist").

- 1. Commission Details: The Artist will create a custom piece of art for the Client based on the Client's specifications. The Client will provide the Artist with a detailed description of the desired artwork ("Artwork Description") and any reference materials that may be helpful in creating the artwork. The Artist will provide the Client with a detailed proposal outlining the scope and cost of the Commission ("Proposal"). The Client must approve the Proposal in writing before the Commission can begin.
- 2. Payment: The Client will pay the Artist a fee of Fee for the Commission, as outlined in the Proposal. The Client will also pay any additional fees for materials or services as outlined in the Proposal. A non-refundable deposit of 50% of the full payment, \$50%Fee, is due upon the Client accepting the Proposal. The remaining balance is due upon completion of the Commission. If the Client is late on either payments, the Artist reserves the right to withhold the Commission or cancel the Contract.
- 3. Revisions: The Artist will provide the Client with preliminary sketches or drafts of the artwork for approval ("Preliminary Artwork"). The Client may request revisions to the Preliminary Artwork up to Number times. Any additional revisions beyond Number will be subject to additional fees at the rate of Rate per revision.
- 4. Completion Date: The Artist will use their best efforts to complete the Commission by the agreed upon completion date, but does not guarantee that the Commission will be completed by that date.
- 5. Copyright: The Artist retains the copyright to the artwork, but grants the Client a perpetual, non-exclusive license to use the artwork for personal, non-commercial purposes. The Client may not sell or distribute the artwork without the express written permission of the Artist.
- 6. Governing Law: This Contract shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of State.
- 7. Entire Agreement: This Contract constitutes the entire agreement between the Client and the Artist and supersedes any prior understandings or agreements, whether written or oral.

By accepting this Contract, the Client acknowledges that they have read and understand the terms and conditions set forth above and agree to be bound by them.
